

## (4c) Teacher Support Notes

Poster campaign	Legal. Could be illegal if the sign is unauthorised
Non-peaceful demonstration	Illegal - Blocking the road. This is an obstruction and involves criminal damage to the surface of the road
Bombing/Terrorism	Illegal - 7 <sup>th</sup> July 2005. Four suicide bombers attacked the London transport system, killing themselves and 52 innocent people
Blocking the Road	Illegal - Obstruction. Also criminal damage and damage to road surface
Climbing Buildings	Illegal - New Fathers 4 Justice group. Public Order Offence. Buildings belong to someone and the emergency services can be put in danger when trying to remove the protesters
Graffiti	Illegal - Criminal damage. Racial Hate Crime
Threatening behaviour	Illegal - Possession of an offensive weapon. Threatening behaviour
Threatening letter	Illegal - Racially aggravated criminal damage. E.g. if the brick has been thrown through a window
Burglary	Illegal - Breaking in to a building with the intention of stealing information to discredit or attack an organisation
Releasing captive animals	Illegal - Public Order Offence and Burglary. (Burglary includes the offences of trespass, breaking and entering and criminal damage)
Bombarding a website to close it down	Illegal - Malicious communications.
